

The good faith effort (GFE) review procedures consist of four phases designed to assess a contractor's performance in complying with DFA's Section 342(c)(2). At the end of each phase, a decision will be made whether or not to proceed to the next phase. When the results of Phase I are inconclusive, the process will continue into Phase II. Only if it is determined that the contractor has failed to provide "satisfactory" good faith effort support documentation despite OMWI assistance, will the assessment proceed to Phases III and IV.
